Your first examination

After you meet your dental team, we will first conduct a thorough examination of your entire mouth, including the teeth, surrounding tissue, gums and jaw. We may choose to carry out dental x-rays in order to check between the teeth and underneath older fillings for any signs of disease or decay. Our hygiene team will then give your teeth a professional clean.

A personal file of your dental health will be created to help us determine the best treatment plan for your needs. At every stage we will discuss your dental situation and all possible outcomes with you, so that we can create a treatment plan specifically designed to meet your needs. We encourage any queries or concerns you may have at any point during your treatment.
